The US Machinegun Armory debuts the only Law Enforcement M249/Mk46 weapon system.

Las Vegas, Nevada (January 21, 2010)

At this year's Shot Show show in Las Vegas, the US Machinegun Armory unveiled yet another belt-fed firearm - in fact, a development upon its recently debuted semi-atuo M249/Mk46.

This time the company has debuted the world's only M249/Mk46 platform with burst-pack, semi-auto and/or full-auto options.

This new weapon it targeted towards Law Enforcement agencies that require a stand-and-hold type of firearm but which typically cannot justify a full-auto-only "military" weapon.

Though similar to the current military M249s and Mk46s produced primarily by FN, the US Machinegun Armory has created a weapon system that looks like the M249/Mk46 but uses an H&K trigger pack and fires in the closed bolt position using a hammer and firing pin.

The US Machinegun Armory weapon, called the MGA Mk46LE SAW, uses most external Milspec accessories such as barrels, top covers, picatinny rails, etc. While the SAW moniker stands for "Squad Automatic Weapon" in the military, the SAW designation for this new weapon stands for "Semi Auto Weapon."

No other company has ever before married the FN-style machineguns with the H&K trigger packs to produce these semi-auto and selective-fire weapons and the US Machinegun Armory is in the process of patenting the design and process.

Law Enforcement agencies appear to be purchasing this weapon now in large numbers.

Moreover, various DOE, Homeland Security and Department of Defense groups are expressing interest in this new weapon.
